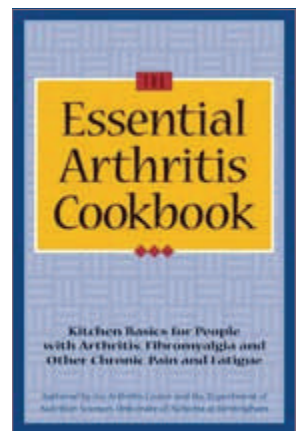

Weighted Cuff Helps Steady a Disposable Razor

This **Weighted Cuff Holder** has hidden weight to help steady a shaky hand. Slip the handle of a standard disposable razor into the holder pocket. The holder has a ½" wide strap that fits comfortably over the hand. It closes securely with a Velcro closure. The vendor says the weighted cuff minimizes grasping pressure on fingers and improves hand control for shaving. We found this item for less than \$32.00. The vendor says that the **E-Z Door Latch** is 5 to 10 times bigger than your current push latch, and a larger target means it



is easier to see. And more handle means more leverage, less effort, and easier to open. No tools Required, and it installs in seconds. The black molded polymer push disk

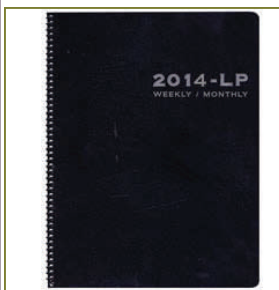

One-inch bold black numbers printed on bright white paper makes it easier to see than smaller calendars. View a month at a time when the calendar is opened. It shows holidays and includes plenty of room for notes on each day plus an additional notes and appointments section at the top of each month. The lowest price we found this item for is \$7.95. Search the words "2014 jumbo print calendar". For those who would like to carry your organizer with you, we found this **2014 Large Print Organizer** for \$21.99. Designed with the low vision person in mind, it has easy to read large print pages in a sleek classic style leatherette cover. The 8.5"x11" with 146-page spiral bound book opens to 17" x 11".
