This Device Helps You Open Ring-Pull Tops on Cans

Ring-pull lids can be frustrating and difficult to open. The vendor says “slide the **Ring Pull Can Opener** under the ring and as far as possible”. This gives you the leverage you need to cleanly and neatly pull back the lid. A gentle pull of the handle rolls back the lid. While this kitchen aid is very useful on items such as tuna cans, dog and cat food cans, soup cans, etc., **it is not intended for use on soda cans.**

This lightweight plastic tool has built-in finger grips. The lowest price we found for this item is \$2.95. Use your favorite search engine with the words “Ring Pull Can Opener” to find a vendor located near you.



Now You Can Beat The Heat...

... with the handy and innovative **2-in-1 Mist and Hydration Bottle**. With its tapered ergonomic shape and easy-grip rubber outer insulating sleeve, this bottle is ideal for those who have Parkinson's and other dexterity challenges. Use it to help you get your daily intake of water. Press the mister to keep cool and turn the lid to drink out of the pop-up straw.



This and similar products are available from various vendors. We found prices ranging from \$9.95-\$12.95 for this bottle. Search “2-in1 mist and hydration bottle” on your search engine to find a bottle that keeps you cooler for the summer.

Foot Rocker is designed to hold the foot in the optimal position for proper stretching. The vendor says “just 3 repetitions of 30 seconds each provides an effective way to help relieve the lower body pain associated with Plantar Fascists, Achilles Tendonitis, Ankle Strain and other chronic conditions”. Solid ABS design with rubber safety-grip treads keeps any size foot safely in place. This and similar products are available from various online vendors for less than \$11.99. Set a Nap Timer with One Touch

Instantly set a 15, 30, or 60-minute timer for your naps with the touch of a button with the **Napper Low Vision Clock**. The vendor say “naps can leave you refreshed and may even have health benefits, including reduced risk of heart attack and stroke, and improved mental performance”. The Napper is an easy to use alarm clock

featuring 3 one-touch nap timer buttons. Press multiple buttons for other time amounts.

For example; press “30” and “15” for a 45-minute nap, or press “60”



twice if you wish to take a 2-hour nap. It also has a traditional morning wake-up alarm with snooze. Set your naptime without changing your morning wake-up time. This gadget is perfect for anyone with low vision. The time is displayed in bold black numbers on a LCD screen. Requires 2AA batteries (not Included). The **Napper Low Vision Clock** is available online for \$14.50. Using your favorite search engine, type in the words “Low vision clock” to find a alarm clock that best suits your needs.

Keep Vital Documents Safe From Fire...

...with the **Fire- Resistant Document Bag**.

Keep those vital documents and photos you can't afford to lose safe from fire. The vendor says that the soft-woven fiberglass bag protects up to 1000 degrees F. Great for passports, deeds, and birth certificates, this document bag can hold legal-size documents. **NOTE:**

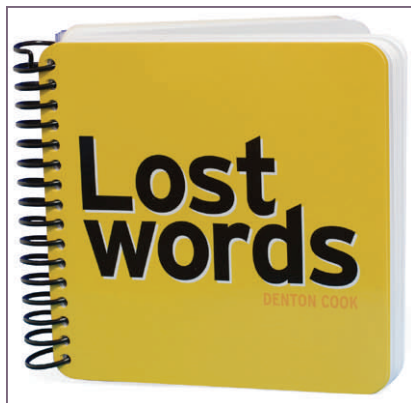

There are a lot of people who, for different reasons, have difficulty finding the right words for things. There are also many people, like some dementia and stroke patients, who have completely lost the ability to speak. **Lost Words**, written by Denton Cook, has more than 290 pictures and their corresponding words. The book is spiral bound for ease of constant use.



There are also a few plastic pockets inside for keeping photographs in, and pages for personal notes. This useful reference book can be a great help for both patients and caregivers. Word search the title "**Lost Words** by Denton Cook" to find a copy online. We found this book for \$12.95.

This Vest Will Help Support a Weak Arm

The **Muff Vest** was designed by a spouse of a stroke survivor. This vest provides support for a flaccid arm. The weight of the stroke arm is distributed and effectively supported over both shoulders. The **Muff Vest** provides arm control, even when the user is bending forward. The large front horizontal pocket is open on both ends, allowing the wearer to reach through the pocket to place their impaired arm in the support. The vest features a universal fit for either left or right arm support, and fits both males and females. Use the words "**Muff Vest**" to search for this item online. Several vendors offer this item for \$71.99.
