2015-2016 Riverside TRIP Program Performance

Measured at the equator, the Earth has a circumference of 24,901.5 miles. For the program year from July 1st 2015 through the end of June 2016 one thousand fifteen "unique", transportation deprived TRIP Program riders in Riverside County California received enough volunteer rides to doctors, grocery stores and other needed destinations to circle the earth 78.6 times!!



Because TRIP riders do not drive, do not have family to provide needed transportation, and are unable to use public transportation alternatives, nearly all of them require TRIP assistance to enable them to access needed medical services but TRIP also helps them to continue to live on their own in their own homes and communities.

Overall 30% of the 119,555 trips were for medical purposes, 20% to grocery stores,18% for other subsistence purposes, and the remaining 38,000 trips were for purposes that enhance the quality of life of our riders. Remember that TRIP riders are low-income, sick, elderly, disabled and alone people who do not drive, cannot use public transportation options and generally have no family members to assist them.

TRIP Riverside has been operating successfully since 1993 and has provided over 1.855 MILLION trips for thousands of Riverside County residents.
