Afraid of Slipping on a Wet Bathroom Floor?

This convenient alarm tells you whenever there's a puddling of water from an overflowing sink or toilet or other mishap. In addition to posing a risk of falls, pooling water also can migrate to carpeting or seep through the floor, causing considerable damage. But **The Water Alarm** sounds the minute it detects water. The monitor sits on the floor with tiny prongs in each of its three feet to alert you instantly when a puddle forms. There are no wired sensors to unplug or detach from the wall, so you can turn it off simply by picking it up. No batteries to remove or switches to turn off. And it's

easy to install. Just insert a 9-volt battery (not included) and place it on the floor. The vendor says it will operate for up to one year on the battery,
