## Create Extra Doorway Clearance for Your Wheelchair or Walker



The **Swing Away Offset Door Hinges** give you the extra clearance needed for wheelchairs and walkers without cutting a larger door frame and installing larger doors. The hinges are designed to swing your door completely clear of the opening. The vendor says that because the expandable Z shaped door hinges use the same screws and holes as the existing hinges, you can retrofit your doorway to handle most residential door sizes. 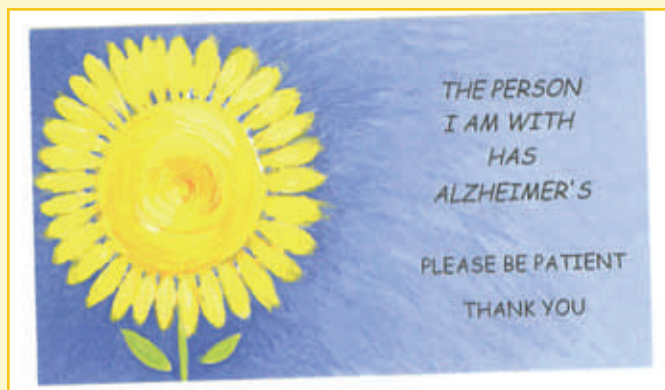
## Let Others Know They Need to Be Patient...

## Increase the Height of Your Furniture to Improve Your Mobility

As anyone with limited mobility knows, getting up from chairs, sofas and even a bed can be difficult if they're too low to the ground. **Easy Risers** address this problem by adding an extra 2" to 5" to the height of existing furniture. ## **Towel Racks Should Not Be Used as Grab Bars**

No more grabbing the towel rack when you lose your balance. The **Safety Tub and Shower Bar** features suction cups that the vendor says lock securely on smooth surfaces like porcelain or fiberglass, so it will provide a steady hold on the edge of a bathtub or shower wall. Special levers flip up when you want to remove or reposition the grabber. This model comes with a red/green changing safety indicator so you can easily check to make sure the grabber is securely attached to the surface. It measures 11" long x 3"1/4" wide so you can easily take it with you when you travel. It is available for \$14.95 at Aids for Arthritis.
