Hear The Correct Dosage Instructions

Designed and patented by a pharmacist and a physician, The **Talking RX** is a revolutionary tool that helps patients take their medications as prescribed. The portable and re-useable device attaches to and fits common prescription bottles. Through its built-in digital memo recorder, **Talking RX** provides up to sixty seconds of recorded instructions about the medical prescription: when to take the medicine, how to take it, and other important information from a patient's physician or caregiver. For Example: "Mom, this is your arthritis medication; make sure you take it with food so it doesn't upset your stomach." The patient plays back these instructions by pressing the raised red button on the side of the **Talking RX** device. The voice message plays back in 80-85 db, ideal for senior who are hard of hearing. This item is available online from various suppliers that sell AT products for \$18.95-\$41.13. 
Maintain Healthy Hands...

The vendor says the **Hand Exercise Putty** is soft and airy, making it easy to squeeze, pinch and stretch as you work your muscles. The price range for this item from various vendors is \$3.99-\$6.99. Search the words "hand putty exercise therapy."



Cool Touch Microwave Bowl

Even though your food is piping hot, this **Cool Touch Microwave Bowl** stays cool. The interior ceramic bowl heats food while the exterior plastic bowl with easy grip handles lets you grab meals straight out of the microwave. The lid prevents splatters for easy clean up. Also doubles as a storage container. Microwave soup bowl set includes 24-oz. ceramic bowl, plastic holder and vented lid. The lowest price we found for this item is \$9.99. Some people believe that ladybugs bring good luck. These lovely ladybug designs show vibrant colors and are a great for a quick magnification on the go. The vendor says the 1.25" lens size and 3X magnifiers on a 28" chain are fun, practical, and good



looking. With the pendent design you can make sure you don't lose your magnifier, it's always around your neck. Use it to check medication bottles, menus, and price tags without wearing your reading glasses. We found these **Ladybug Pendants** on line for \$14.95. No Need To Worry About Slicing Your Fingers When You Chop

Safe Slice Knife Finger Guard keeps fingers safe from sharp knives. The vendor says this is the perfect tool for protecting fingers. Just slip your index finger and thumb into its thimble-like pockets; a textured gripping surface holds foods firmly while a flexible body protects your hand and fingers. It's hand washable and 3" wide x 3 1/2" high. The lowest price we found this item for is \$2.98. Word search "safe slice knife finger guard."



Another handy finger guard is the **Bagel Holder Slicer**. The acrylic bagel holder slicer securely grips a bagel while you safely slice lengthwise through the handy side slots. The vendor says even those with limited hand dexterity can slice easily with this

bagel cutter. It's 4 1/2" long x 2" wide x 4 1/4" high, easy to wash and top-rack dishwasher safe. This and similar products are available from various online suppliers that sell assistive technology for less than \$4.99. Search the words "bagel cutter holder" to find an online supplier.
