Keep Your Place and Magnify What You Are Reading

This is the perfect guide for those with low vision.

The **EZ Magnibar** has either an aqua or yellow tracker line;

when placed on text, it helps prevent the reader from losing their place. In addition, since it is a magnifying bar, the text is 1.5 times larger, making it easier to see. The **Magnibar** comes in two lengths, 6" or 9" and is1" wide with the tracker line being ½" wide. The highlight line is tall enough to typically hold one line of standard text. Just slide the bar up, down, left or right to continue reading. The bar is made of clear, sturdy lucite. These and



similar products are available from various online suppliers for less than \$4.95. Search the words "EZ Magnibar" to find your reading aid.

Easy-To-Open, Stackable Canisters

Click Clack Canisters are ergonomically designed lids that



features soft-touch, squeeze toggles for easy, one-handed opening and closing. Airtight seals keep food fresh longer and they stack easily for efficient storage. Unbreakable, dishwasher and microwave safe, they are a must for anyone with dexterity or vision impairments. The

price range of various size canisters and vendors is \$9.31 to \$15.55. Search the words "click clack canisters one handed" to find a supplier near you.

Extra Wide Talking Scale

This **Talking Scale** has a 550 lb. weight capacity with an extra wide tempered glass top and a stable weighing

platform. There is a two-person memory feature, with an easy to hear voice. The scale features a large LCD display and a low-battery indicator. The vendor says this is a great AT product for the visually impaired. The lowest price we found for this scale is \$39.95. or eReader without having to hold the device. The **Tab Grabber** base clamp is designed specifically for mounting to a wheelchair frame. The gooseneck arm is flexible for optimal positioning yet holds firmly in place for touch screen use. The **Tab Grabber** easily swings out of the way when entering or exiting the wheelchair. The multi-axis rotating head can be adjusted to any viewing orientation. The retractable clips will extend to fit any size tablet and can be attached either to the corners or anywhere along the edges of the device. This Gadget Becomes a "Stirr" for Every Pot!

The **Stirr** "walks" around the pot, blending flavors and keeping ingredients from sticking or clumping,



in effect stirring so you don't have to. The vendor says the soft padded feet won't scratch so it's safe for nonstick pots or pans. There's even a paddle that sweeps across the bottom of the pot. Constructed of nylon and silicone, the **Stirr** is operated by (4) AA batteries (not included) and features three operating speeds. And according to the vendor, the detachable blades are dishwasher safe. The **Stirr** measures approximately 7-1/8" high x 3-1/2" in diameter. This item is available online from various vendors that sell AT products for \$29.95- \$36.95. Search the words "pot stir kitchen" to get your helping hand in the kitchen.

The **Baggy Rack** is ideal for filling plastic baggies with sauce, soup or cereal because it holds the plastic bags upright and open so they are always easy to fill. The vendor says with this gadget, plastic baggies will never "slump" and spill contents on the counter, and will always stay upright while you work. The rack telescopes to a full "10" to accommodate sandwich, quart and gallonsized bags. A set of two **Baggy Racks** costs \$9.95. Search the words "baggy racks" to find a little extra help.
