## If You Have Trouble Hearing the Doorbell.....

The **Alertmaster Door Announcer AM-DX** amplifies the chime or buzzer so you can easily hear it when it rings. The device mounts right next to your existing doorbell chime or buzzer and automatically picks up the sound. According to the vendor, it is wireless so it does not have to be plugged in or hard-wired. With the **AM-RX2 Remote Receiver**, you can also connect the receiver to lamps in any room up to 80 feet away from the unit and the lights will automatically flash in a distinctive pattern when the doorbell rings. Lights on the receiver also flash to tell you the doorbell is ringing. Again, it is wireless, so you can just plug it in and it is ready to go. 
